- 5. World language requirement, eight hours. Must complete through Beginning II of a world language.
- 6. Additional degree requirement, 26 hours, a minimum of 10 hours must be upper level. Consult with faculty advisor. A minor is required; follow respective minor requirements. Select additional electives as needed.

A student's degree program requirements are those specified in the catalog in effect at the time of declaration of program major. If not on the Guaranteed 8-semester degree plan, students may choose to meet the program requirements specified in the catalog for a later year from when they began their program of study. Students must meet the above program requirements and the graduation requirements as indicated by institutional and college policy.
